Clinton Public Library Home Delivery Application

The Clinton Public Library offers a delivery program for those residents who cannot get to the library in the traditional way because of:

- Permanent or temporary physical disability
- Visual impairment
- Temporary convalescence from illness, injury, or surgery, or other extenuating circumstance.
- If you are a live-in caregiver of a homebound person

The homebound service includes:

- Free delivery once every twenty-one days (21) to your home
- A call from the volunteer or staff member prior to delivering the materials
- Personally selected books
- Books that are due will be picked up and returned to the library.

Seven-day DVDs may be borrowed, but it is the responsibility of the homebound patron to get someone to return them to the library as they do not fall within the twenty-one day service.

If you feel you are eligible to receive this service, or know someone who may be interested, please call The Clinton Public Library at 765-832-8349 and speak to one of our staff members to see if you are eligible, what you would like to receive, and sign you up. If you do not have a library card, we will help you fill out an application and have you register on the day of the first delivery. This service is open to all ages.

A staff visit will be arranged. During the first visit reading preferences will be discussed.
